

Effects and Penalties of Dumping

Trash dumped in unauthorized locations is not just appalling, it can cause major public health and safety concerns such as an increase in rodents and mosquitos, related illnesses, and physical and chemical hazards like protruding nails and harmful fluids. Dumping is also illegal and punishable by the Texas Health and Safety Code 365 (www.statutes.legis.ts.us).

How to Report Illegal Dumping

Filling an illegal dumping report is simple and confidential. Only a few details are needed, such as the type of trash and the location.
